NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 - 16.
- 1.2 RYA prescriptions will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all classes. Class starts may be offered depending on entry numbers.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter on line from May 1st 2016 at www.weymouthregatta.co.uk/dinghies
- 2.3 The Regatta will be restricted to 120 entries.

3 RACE AREA

- 3.1 Racing will take place in Weymouth Bay or in Portland Harbour as appropriate.
- 3.2 All dinghies will be located at Castle Cove Sailing Club, Old Castle Road, Weymouth.

4 FEES

4.1 Fees for the regatta are:	Double handers	£40.00
	Single handers	£30.00
	Junior helm (under 18)	£20.00

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration will be from 0830 with a competitors briefing at 1030 on Saturday 9th July.
- 5.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 12:55 on Saturday 9th and 10:25 on Sunday 10th July.
- 5.3 There are 3 races scheduled each day.
- 5.3 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1500.

6 PRIZES

- 6.1 Prizes will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class.

7 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 7.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to race. The Organising Authority will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 7.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2million or equivalent.
